Dear patrons and sponsors:

In 2019, St. Benedict League of Chapters is a new name adopted by the Southern Region Vietnamese Eucharistic Youth Movement in the U.S.A. We are a nonprofit (not-for-profit) organization that has been granted tax-exempt status by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) according to Section 501(c)(3).

Originally established 1988, our organization has developed and expanded into 21 chapters from different churches spanning across the five southern states of Arkansas, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Texas, and Louisiana.

Our purposes are aligned with the national Vietnamese Eucharistic Youth Movement in the U.S.A. We are a youth movement aim for the Christian formation of children and young people. The youth movement invites young people to develop a personal friendship with Jesus, by living each day closely united with Him through prayer, communion, sacrifice, and good works. Each year, St. Benedict League of Chapters host several activities that include at least two youth-leader training camps, retreats, and at least one convention for eligible youth members to participate. These activities are essential opportunities for young people from the different chapters and parishes to come together to learn, grow, and share their faith as well as well as to form leadership skills. Technology cannot replace the personal presence and human interactions in which young people need to feel acknowledged, valued, loved, and cared for. Our annual budget can range from \$30,000 to more than \$100,000.

In summer 2022, our Knights and Companions Conventions anticipates welcoming more than 600 youths, leaders, and volunteers. The goal is to raise at least \$25,000 to help reduce the registration fee, transportation cost, and activities.
